TOTAL SOLAR ECLIPSE

STATUS

Teton Eclipse Town and County planners are posted at the JH Live concert this evening at the base of Snow King Mountain in the Town of Jackson. The Eclipse tent presence allows locals and visitors an opportunity to meet planners and pick up free, pocket-sized Teton Total Solar Eclipse Official Survival Guides before August 21. Guides serve as an eclipse primer or piece of local history to educate the public in advance of the long-awaited event.

TODAY & TOMORROW

Town of Jackson crossing guards kept traffic moving in the core downtown area today while providing for safe pedestrian crossing. The same operations will remain in effect tomorrow through the eclipse. All agency partners will have additional staff placed while continuing to operate business as usual. Additional officers from around the state of Wyoming were sworn in this afternoon by Teton County Sheriff Jim Whalen, giving them jurisdiction outside of their home units to assist here with the eclipse. They will be strategically dispersed throughout the area in an effort to maintain safety and shortened response times.
