## TOTAL SOLAR ECLIPSE

Saturday, August 19, 2017

### STATUS

Traffic remains moderate overall, including within the Town of Jackson and in Grand Teton National Park.

The numerous public information booths located throughout the area are appreciated and well received by both locals and visitors.

Many locations in the Bridger-Teton NF are at capacity with limited parking and camping, including Skyline Drive and Elkhart Park, the Green River corridor, and the lower part of the Gros Ventre drainage. Areas with the most availability are the Upper Gros Ventre drainage/Slate Creek and Spread Creek.

Grand Teton NP is seeing limited turnover each day in their designated campgrounds, but the sites are quickly refilling.

### TODAY & TOMORROW

Elevated fire weather conditions can be expected to continue through the weekend, with low humidity and occasional gusty winds. This increases the chances of wildfire starts and spreading.

Weather models are starting to come together to more accurately predict possible cloud cover and precipitation for Monday.
