TOTAL SOLAR ECLIPSE

Sunday, August 20, 2017

STATUS

Traffic reports still indicate there are no heavily congested roads in the Town of Jackson or Teton County, WY. WYDOT reported roughly an 18% increase in traffic counts when looking at a five-year average for the third Saturday in August.

Federal land management agencies are reporting increases in out-of-bounds camping incidents.

Dispersed camping on the Bridger-Teton NF has reached capacity in the lower Gros Ventre, Toppings Lake, Shadow Mountain, and Curtis Canyon areas. Alternative camping areas include Spread Creek, Upper Gros Ventre, and Togwotee areas.

There is still a slight turnover each morning in Grand Teton NP campsites, but they quickly refill.

TODAY & TOMORROW

Weather computer models are honing in on Monday's anticipated cloud cover, with increased confidence in accurate forecasting as we get closer to eclipse day. A Red Flag Warning (fire danger) is in effect for Eastern Idaho: <http://bit.ly/2wu6cZ9>
