STATUS

Federal lands managers as well as Town and County resources reported an increase in traffic today with notable areas of activity north of Jackson and on Teton Pass.

The Bridger-Teton NF is continuing to post dispersed camping availability on the homepage of their web site.

TODAY & TOMORROW

Most of the weather models are consistently forecasting favorable weather conditions for eclipse viewing tomorrow.

Smoke from western fires may move into the area later in the day on Monday but is not currently considered a potential threat to eclipse viewing conditions.
